A good website to use is www.topmarks.co.uk

Click learning games on the dark blue border at the top.

Click Maths games for 3 to 5 years.

Choose a category - counting.

Scroll down and click on a counting game.

This games gives objects to count, numbers to click on at the bottom that when you run the cursor over, the number is said out loud. This really builds on counting skills and number recognition.

For phonics, use the same site but click $\underline{\text{English games}}$ for $\underline{3}$ to $\underline{5}$ years.

Choose a category - <u>letters and sounds.</u>

Scroll down and click on the game - phoneme pop.

Our maths focus will be number recognition, counting, and shapes.

The books we will be reading are:

Superbat by Carr Matt

Room on the broom by Julia Donaldson and Axel Scheffler

Princess Primrose by Alex T. Smith

We have taught the letter sounds: m,a,s,d,t,i,n,p,g,o, c and k

The children will be learning: u, b, f, e, l, h, r, j, v, y, w and z.
